

# *Event Rules*

1. A team of players tees off with the best ball on each series of shots being selected (including putts). Men and women will play from the tees designated by the course professional.
2. All lies may be improved, except in hazard. In the event that a hazard lie is chosen as the best ball, the player who placed the ball in the hazard will shoot first. The other players will drop a ball at arms length in the approximate vicinity of the first player's ball position.
  - Red Stakes: Lateral Hazards
  - Yellow Stakes: Water Hazards
  - White Lines: Ground Under Repair
  - White Stakes: Out of Bounds
3. If a player putts the ball on a putting green and by mistake taps the ball in the hole, the remaining players shall not putt, as the hole shall be considered holed out.
4. Scorecards must be signed by two (2) members of the team. Please bring completed scorecards to the course professional immediately following play.
5. Ties will be broken by the format determined by the course professional.
6. Please keep your pace of play at a ready golf level. **Par is your highest score!** If the hole is not holed out after par, please pick up and move on.
7. Golfer's Handicap "putt stick" is only good on the putting green and each inch can only be used one time. All 36 inches can be used at once, however only once during the entire golf outing.
8. Mulligans, up to 3 per person, may be purchased for \$5.00 each or three (3) for \$10.00 at the start of the day. Other games for the day include:
  - Longest Drive—Men
  - Longest Drive—Women
  - Closest to the Pin—Men
  - Closest to the Pin—Women
